Tokyo Marathon 2016 will be televised in over 144 countries and territories around the world

Tokyo Marathon Foundation (Koto-ku, Tokyo, President/CEO Koji Sakurai) announced that Tokyo Marathon 2016, which is scheduled to be held on Sunday February 28, 2016, will be televised in over 144 countries and territories around the world. The race will be on air with major broadcasters such as LeTV and Eurosport (46 countries and territories in Asia), SuperSport (53 countries and territories in Africa), NBC (USA), Claro Sports and ESPN (44 countries and territories in North, Central and Latin America, and Caribbean).
