Overview of the Tokyo Marathon 2027

The Tokyo Marathon 2027 will launch various new initiatives as it celebrates its 20th anniversary. The key points of the Tokyo Marathon 2027 are presented below.

[Key Points]

■ Japan's largest marathon! The marathon capacity will be increased to 40,000 runners

The Tokyo Marathon 2027 has increased the capacity from 39,000 to 40,000 runners to allow even more people to participate.

■ The biggest grand prize of any of the Abbott World Marathon Majors

The prize money awarded to the men's and women's Marathon Elite Athlete champions has been increased. The world's top athletes will be competing in a thrilling race as they vie for the \$170,000 champion's prize, the largest ever in the Abbott World Marathon Majors (AbbottWMM). (As of June 22, 2026)

■ A new marathon (42.195 km) para-athlete division and entry categories for people with disabilities

A new para-athlete division has been created to heighten the appeal of marathon elite racing by people with disabilities. In conjunction with this, new entry categories have been created for people with disabilities, further promoting their participation in sports. Due to these changes, the 10.7km run has been superseded by the marathon.

■ Creation of a new Duo Team division

To create a society in which everyone can enjoy running, we began a trial introduction of Duo Teams at the Tokyo Marathon 2025. Starting with the Tokyo Marathon 2027, the Duo Teams is becoming an official division and will be seeking interested runners. In the Duo Teams, runners work in two-person teams of one buggy rider and one pusher, aiming for the finish line together.

Thanks to the support of our runners, volunteers, spectators, and local community partners, the Tokyo Marathon is celebrating a huge milestone: its 20th anniversary!

To mark this special anniversary event, we are expanding the marathon capacity to a record-breaking 40,000 runners. Furthermore, by boosting the marathon's top prize to a world-class level with an eye on the global record, we will realize a thrilling race that leads the world. In addition, we will introduce new categories for Duo Teams and athletes with disabilities to create a race where a diverse range of people can take on the challenge.

At the same time, we will promote social contribution activities required for the new era, and strengthen our sustainability initiatives, such as waste reduction, environmental preservation, and the promotion of DEI (Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion), to achieve sustainable event operations that connect to the future.

Under the concept "The Day We Unite." we express our deep gratitude as we host the 20th edition, and we look forward to continuing to build this event together with all of you in the future.

■ Key Visual Concept

The Tokyo Marathon 2027 will mark its 20th edition.

The Tokyo Marathon logo, which we updated in 2016, uses multicolored lines to symbolize the diverse values and objectives of those who participate in the marathon. These lines intersect and weave together in various ways, which represents the fact that the day of the Tokyo Marathon is "The Day We Unite."

In the visual design for the 2027 marathon, we turned our attention to the individual people that take part, before they set out in their lives, forming the lines that will interweave with other participants.

We shined a light on the dots that represent each person.

Everyone has their own body, and their own heart. They shine a light on themselves, taking care of their minds and bodies, keeping them under control and sometimes letting them soar.

Everyone is the main character in their own life. When people take a good look at themselves, they also see what surrounds them. This way of looking at the world leads people to think of others, to cheer them on, to offer their support. To shine a light on them.

At the root of it all is the potential of each point—of each individual person. Each person shines their own light, as do those around them. And the lights people shine on others reflect and combine to create a powerful, resplendent light.

This beaming light could be the light of the future, a future in which the Tokyo Marathon is the goal of runners and races around the world.

From single points of light to beams. From beams to fields of light. From these fields of light, new points are born, to become their own beams and form their own fields of light.

Through running, people's spirits and feelings unite the marathon and unite Tokyo, spreading out into the world.

We've gone back to the basics and designed a new starting point for the 20th anniversary of the Tokyo Marathon.

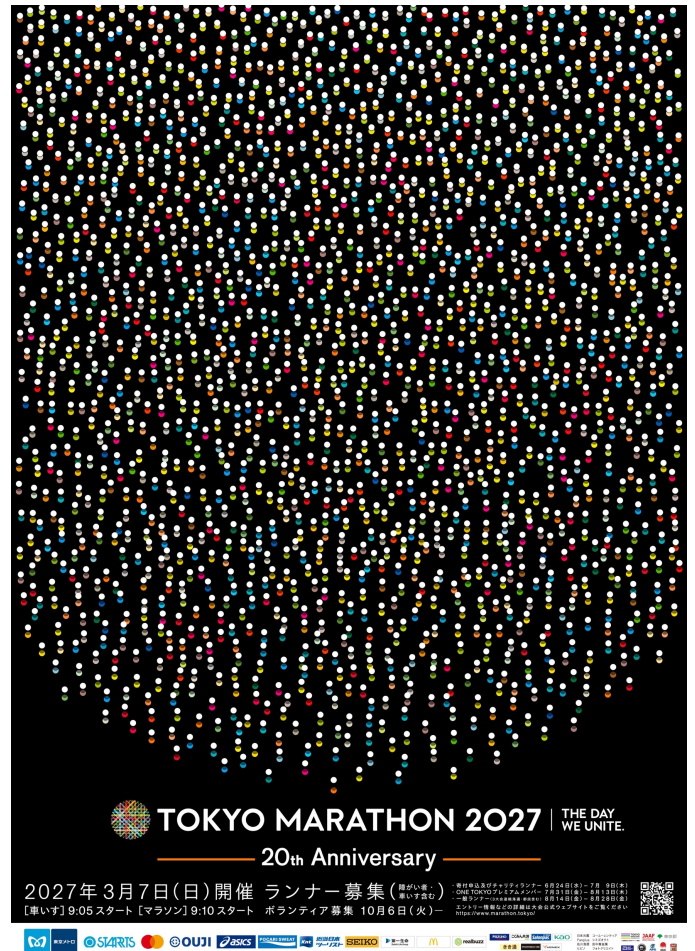
Takahiro Yasuda is an art director and a graphic designer based in Tokyo, who is also a member of the creative association CEKAI.

[Implementing the Green Mileage Program]

Tokyo Marathon 2027 gathers donations to the Tokyo Marathon Foundation's "[Green Mileage Program](#)" from marathon participants. These donations can be made by people selected as runners, and the choice of whether to donate is made when paying the participation fee.

The Green Mileage Program is a carbon offset program aimed at achieving net zero emissions by contributing to greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reductions and absorption through activities such as running, thereby offsetting emissions of substances that cause global warming. For every mile (approximately 1.6 km) run, 100 yen is donated to greenery conservation activities.

In Tokyo Marathon 2027, 2,600 yen, equivalent to the 42.195 km (26 miles) of the marathon course, are donated by each marathon participant taking part in the program. These donations are used for reforestation and environmental protection activities.

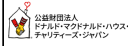

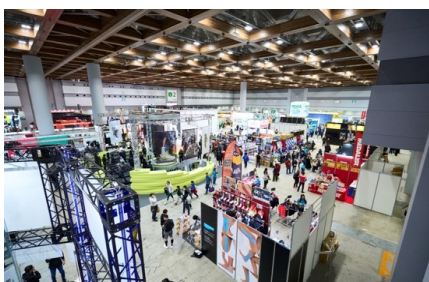
